- Exemplos:**
- You want to build a sand castle like the one we built last month.
 - Verbo irregular "build" (construir).
 - Passado simples e particípio é "built" (construiu / construído).
 - He bet me that I couldn't run six miles without stopping. I proved him wrong: I ran nine miles before I had to catch my breath.
 - Verbo irregular "bet" (apostou) passado simples.
 - As três formas (infinitivo, passado simples e particípio) são exatamente iguais.
 - Verbo irregular "run" ("Correr").
 - "Ran" (correu) é o passado simples e "run" (corrida) também é o passado particípio.
 - I awoke to find that a spider had bitten me. Although the wound didn't bleed, it itched terribly.
 - Verbo irregular "awoke" (despertou) - passado simples de "awake" (despertar).
 - Verbo irregular "bitten" (mordida) é o particípio de "bite" (morder).
 - Verbo irregular "Bleed" (sangrar) está na sua forma infinitiva.
 - Let's drink some of this lemonade. I drank some yesterday and found it delicious.
 - Verbo irregular "drink" (beber) está no infinitivo. "Drank" é o passado simples (bebeu).
 - "Found" (achei - achou) é o passado simples de "Find" (achar / encontrar).
