- Afirmativo**
 - I, he, she, it -> was
 - You, we, they -> were
 - Exemplos
 - I was in Paris in 2010.
 - Carlos was in Tokyo in 2010.
 - We were not together.
 - He was my boyfriend.
- Interrogativo**
 - Was -> I, he, she it?
 - Were -> You, we they?
 - Exemplos
 - Were you in London last year?
 - Was Carlos with you?
 - Were you together?
- Negativo**
 - I, you, he, she -> was not / wasn't
 - You, we, they -> were not / weren't
 - Exemplos
 - I wasn't in Paris in 2010.
 - Carlos wasn't in Canada in 2010.
 - We weren't in Paris.

 - Exemplo
 - I played soccer with my cousins yesterday.
 - I finished dinner and I did my homework.
 - Interrogativo**
 - Did -> I, you, he, she, it, we, they Play / write / do?
 - Exemplo
 - Did you play soccer yesterday?
 - Did you watch television this morning?
 - Did you do the homework?
 - Negativo**
 - I, you, he, she, it, we, they -> did not/ didn't play / write / do.
 - Exemplo
 - I didn't like the food in the wedding last Saturday.
 - I didn't eat it.

- Ações que eram verdade no passado:**
 - He lived in London for 20 years.
 - They talked on the phone for 30 minutes.
