Butterflies in one's stomach  
Meaning: Muito nervoso  
Example: I was so nervous before my speech, I had butterflies in my stomach.

All bark and no bite  
Meaning: Alguém que faz ameaças, mas não faz nada.  
Example: My boss yells a lot, but he's all bark and no bite.

Which came first, the chicken or the egg?  
Meaning: Uma pergunta que talvez não terá uma resposta correta.  
Example: Normalmente usada isoladamente nesta forma. Which came first, the chicken or the egg?

Wolf in sheep's clothing  
Meaning: Alguém que parece inofensivo, mas é perigoso.  
Example: Don't trust him, he's a wolf in sheep's clothing.

You can't teach an old dog new tricks  
Meaning: Não será fácil mudar a rotina estabelecida de alguém (aprender algo novo).  
Example: My mom won't learn how to use the computer. I guess you can't teach an old dog new tricks.

Guinea pig  
Meaning: Cobalia  
Example: We're conducting a study and we're looking for volunteers to act as guinea pigs.

Hold your horses  
Meaning: Acalmarse, parar  
Example: Hold your horses! There's no need to rush.

I'll be a monkey's uncle  
Meaning: Estar muito surpreso  
Example: Well, I'll be a monkey's uncle. I never thought I'd pass that test.

Let sleeping dogs lie  
Meaning: Deixe-o sozinho, deixe em paz  
Example: I'm not telling the boss about Mark's problem, it's best to let sleeping dogs lie.

Pet peeve  
Meaning: Aborrecimento comum, algo que é especificamente irritante para você  
Example: I hate when people don't put things back where they belong, it's a pet peeve of mine.

Pick of the litter  
Meaning: A melhor escolha ou sua opção favorita  
Example: All the boys want to take her on a date, she can have the pick of the litter.

Puppy love  
Meaning: Sentimentos de amor ou afecção, normalmente inocente e temporário, que ocorre durante a infância ou adolescência  
Example: I had a crush on my next door neighbor, but that was just puppy love.

Like shooting fish in a barrel  
Meaning: Muito fácil de pegar ou enganar  
Example: I'm an expert in auto repair, fixing this is like shooting fish in a barrel.

A little bird (birdie) told me  
Meaning: Alguém me disse secretamente  
Example: I heard you were accepted to Harvard, a little birdie told me!

Bull in a china shop  
Meaning: Pessoa muito desajeitada  
Example: He was like a bull in a china shop, he completely messed everything up.

Animal Idioms

At a snail's pace  
Meaning: Se movendo muito devagar  
Example: Traffic is moving at a snail's pace.

Busy as a bee  
Meaning: Muito ocupado  
Example: My son is working on his science project. He's been as busy as a bee all day.

Open a can of worms  
Meaning: Criar um monte de novos problemas  
Example: You've opened a real can of worms here.

Wild goose chase  
Meaning: Perseguido algo que é muito difícil (ou impossível) de pegar  
Example: You're taking me on a wild goose chase, will you just give me an exact address where I should go?

The world is your oyster  
Meaning: Você tem muitas boas oportunidades em frente de você  
Example: You just graduated from a wonderful university, so the world is your oyster!

Watching like a hawk  
Meaning: Assistir/acompanhar alguma coisa muito de perto  
Example: The boss watches us like a hawk.

Mad as a hornet (USA)  
Meaning: Muito bravo ou furioso  
Example: Mom was as mad as a hornet when we broke the mirror.

Dog eat dog  
Meaning: Muito competitivo  
Example: It's a dog eat dog world out there.

Eagle eyes  
Meaning: Ter uma visão excelente ou assistir alguma coisa de forma atenta, sem perder um detalhe  
Example: The teacher goes over the tests with an eagle eye.

Get your ducks in a row  
Meaning: Organizar as coisas  
Example: I'll be reviewing things to make sure you have your ducks in a row.
